Using RaiseRight.com to order gift cards

You can buy gift cards for a HUGE variety of retailers through the GTC Booster Club and earn money for your child's booster club account while purchasing the things you would buy anyhow.

RaiseRight.com is the online ordering system that we will use to order gift cards. All you have to do is setting up an account at RaiseRight.com. Honestly ... that is the hardest part. ©

To place your scrip orders, you need to first create a RaiseRight account.

Go to <u>raiseright.com</u> and click on the 'Sign Up' button at the top of the page. Next, click 'Join a Program.' You will then need to enter our organization's unique enrollment code (LB68777751946). This code allows the RaiseRight system to link your account activity with our organization. Next, fill in all the required information and click 'Register.' You will be asked to select two challenge questions and provide answers, which will be required if you forget your password. Keep in mind that your answers are case-sensitive.

Once you have set up your account at RaiseRight.com you will be able to order your gift cards.

But let's first talk about the THREE payment options you have:

- 1. **Check or cash:** You can pay your gift cards by check or cash. Just bring a printout of your order and a check/cash to the gym and drop it off in the black booster club mailbox. Usually the digital gift cards will be available as soon as the coordinator has the check/cash in hand.
- 2. **Bank account:** You can pay for your gift cards online. You can securely link a bank account to your RaiseRight account. There will be a small "convenience fee" of 15 cents per transaction. In one transaction you can order ONE gift card or MANY. It doesn't matter. But 15 cents will be added per transaction. If you are concerned about the security of linking your bank account just open a new bank account and just transfer as much money as you need for your scrip orders onto your new account. That way you are on the safe side. This really comes in handy when you order "digital" gift cards (eCards). But more to that later.
- 3. **Credit Card:** You can pay for your gift cards with your credit card (Visa or MasterCard). Please be aware that RaiseRight adds 2.6% to your credit card purchase. Therefore it only makes sense to purchase gift cards which have more than 2.6% return if you pay with a credit card!!

What kind of gift cards can you order at RaiseRight.com?


eCard (digital gift card):

Our organization has decided, that we will only have the option of ordering eCards (digital gift cards). This option might not be available for all retailers, but for most. Here you have to choose your denomination and enter the total amount you want. Please make sure your read the general info on the bottom of the page! Add the gift card to your cart. Once you have all the gift cards you want in your cart, chose your payment option and click "submit".

If you chose to pay with check/cash, please print out your order and drop it off in the black booster club with check or cash. Once the coordinator has received your payment (cash/check), she will approve the order and your digital gift card will be available on your computer/phone shortly after. You can either go to the RaiseRight website and click on "dashboard" to print out your eCard or use the RaiseRight app on your phone to access your gift card. More info about the RaiseRight app below.

Again ... as soon as the coordinator approves the order ... the gift cards will be available to you.

If you chose to pay with credit card or bank account, the gift cards will be available on the RaiseRight website (dashboard) or on your phone through the RaiseRight app after a few minutes! Please imagine the possibilities: You are at Chili's, receive your check. You go online with the RaiseRight app, order your gift cards and pay with your gift card a few minutes later.



RaiseRight App

This is an app on your phone and you can basically order, pay (if you use a credit card or bank account, and use your digital gift cards through it. No more "darn it, I left the gift cards at home". The digital gift cards are on your phone, ready for you to use. And if your significant other has the "app" on their phone too (and you are kind enough to give them the password) they can use the gift card too! Very convenient.

We understand that this whole process seems very overwhelming in the beginning, but as somebody who has used this system for many years, I can promise you that once you use it, it will be so easy and you can make a ton of money (even if it doesn't look much per transaction) through it.

The possibilities are truly endless:

Disney and Delta are some of the retailers. Not a high percentage, but you usually spent a lot of money there and therefore it adds up.

Home Depot and Lowe's. Again, not a high percentage, but buy an appliance for \$1000 and you got \$40 on your account.

If you can convince relatives all around the US to sign up for it (with bank account or credit card) ... that's how they can support your child.

Here are few more "insider tips" for RaiseRight:

- You can use a Kohl's Cares gift card to pay your bill of your Kohl's credit card at Kohl's. Kohl's offers 4%.
- If you buy movie tickets from RaiseRight (Regal Ticket \$10.50 and AMC Ticket \$10 or \$12), you can save money on an adult ticket for most shows. Most evening shows at Regal and AMC are more than this. Both tickets carry a 10% incentive. There are TWO different Regal gift cards on the app. One is a single ticket (for \$10.50) which returns 10% and one is a general gift card, which you can use to EITHER buy a regular priced ticket or food at Regal and this one returns 8%.
- If you use a WalMart gift card at either WalMart or Murphy gas stations, you get an additional 3 cents per gallon off of your gas purchase.
- Some cards carry very high incentives. For example Bath and Body 12%, Gap/Old Navy 14%, L.L. Bean 16%, O'Charley's 13% and Chili's 11%.
- A few times a year, RaiseRight offers a Thank-scrip-ing day for eCards. Many retailers offer higher incentives on this day, some as high as 20%. Sign up for with your bank account or use your credit card to take full advantage of this bonus day. And make sure you sign up to receive their emails, which will announce those days. Last year on Black Friday Old Navy offered 25%!
- Near the end of each semester, RaiseRight offers some low denomination cards (\$5, \$10, \$20 and \$25) that make great gifts for teachers, babysitters, bus drivers and anyone else that is on your holiday or end-of-school shopping list.
